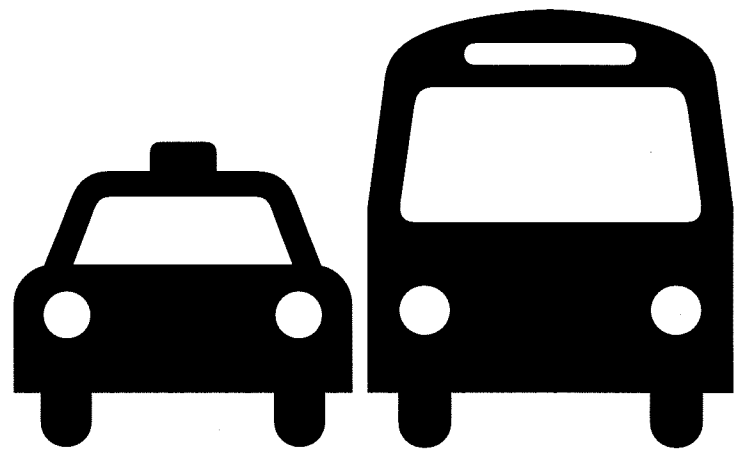

Provide free transportation to VA medical facilities for injured and ill veterans. Works in coordination with Manchester VA facility.

Volunteer driver program for visually impaired individuals. Provides rides for medical appointments, grocery shopping, and peer support groups. Must apply as a client before requesting a ride. Schedule at least 1 week in advance.

Transportation for individuals with disabilities. Rides for social, recreational, and errand purposes. Must enroll as a client before requesting rides. \$2/mile and \$22/hour. 2 weeks advance notice requested for transportation.

Brings veterans to VA appointments in Manchester. Veterans who are eligible for VA health care benefits and have a VA-authorized appointment are automatically eligible.
